This intense red is filled with exotic spice accents to the dried raspberry and cherry paste flavors that show notes of blood orange. Crackling acidity backs the minerally finish, with plenty of savory accents. 177 cases made.

Concentrated cherry tart and raspberry flavors show lithe floral accents, supported by vibrant acidity. Pure-tasting and minerally, with a burnished finish that lingers with saffron accents. 254 cases made.
